Ideas for Effective Posters:

- Posters may not be larger than 36" x 48" (3' by 4').
- Avoid excessive detail: you may have handouts available with backup information.
- Highlight important points with color.
- Use large type. Title should be readable from 6 feet away.
- Place the title of the project prominently at the top of the poster.
- Consult with your faculty sponsor for further assistance.
- Organize the presentation in a logical sequence.
- See example poster template for recommended font sizes.

CREATING A POSTER: Check out the URC website, <http://urc.ucdavis.edu>, under the heading, "2017 Presenter Information" and click on "PowerPoint Poster Tall Template" (portrait) or "PowerPoint Poster Wide Template" (landscape). You are not required to use these templates, so feel free to use any style, colors or format of your choice.

PRINTING: The Undergraduate Research Center will print your poster for free if you upload your poster to Smartsite, in an electronic copy (PPT or PDF), no later than Monday, April, 17, 2017 by 11:55 p.m. Please note that only one poster per person (or per team) will be printed. Be sure to carefully proof your poster before you upload it to Smartsite. If you have questions about your poster, contact Lolita Adkins (lnelson@ucdavis.edu), or Dee Clark (deec Clark@ucdavis.edu).

FORMAT: At the conference, the poster session is "college fair" style. In other words, you will be standing next to your poster talking to conference participants one-on-one. Your poster should be eye catching and easy to read from a distance of approximately 6 feet. Presenters may use the other session times as an opportunity to visit the posters of their colleagues and to locate their assigned poster board. All presenters should register on or before their assigned time, as listed below. An announcement will be made on the hour for poster presenters to switch to the next session displays.
