Conference History

- The Undergraduate Research
 Conference was established in 1990
 - 19 student presenters
- >700 student presenters in 2019
 - Representing all colleges and >85 majors
- The 2020 conference is the first ever virtual conference due to campus response to coronavirus.







New Conference Dates and Format!

- Conference is May 7th May 8th
- Online platform (requires login) to upload and view pre-recorded videos of student research presentation
- Video presentations can be viewed over 2 days (May 7-8)
- Format features online Q&A (occurring over a 2-day period, not live)





Conference Format

- Virtual conference still has many of the same benefits as a traditional format
- Faculty, staff and presenters can login to give feedback and participate in online Q&A
- Student presenters and student "attendees" participating in Q&A will be able to "compete" for awards as Conference VIPs





Benefits of Virtual Conference

- Prepare a research presentation
- Develop communication skills and practice public speaking
- Create a video presentation of your research
 - CV/resume or other professional development
- Get feedback and insight about your research
- Showcase your research to faculty, administrators and other researchers in a scholarly setting
- Excellent resume and skill builder
- Outstanding experience to highlight





Video Presentations

- All presenters will make video presentations
- You can follow your original poster or oral presentation format, or switch to a mixed/different presentation format (as long as it's a video).
- Poster presentations should be 5-10 minutes
- Oral presentations should be 8-12 minutes
- The max time for ANY presentation is 15 minutes

Video Presentation Checklist

https://urc.ucdavis.edu/presenter-checklist

- Finalize poster or slide deck
- Choose video recording software (Zoom, AggieVideo, PowerPoint, etc.)
- Group presenters agree on software, time to record, roles, and who will upload video
- Find best location to record
- Consider lighting, quiet space, equipment





Video Presentation Checklist

- Notify household of recording and duration
- Wear Business Casual clothing
- Practice and review recording
- Edit as needed using features available in selected software
- Save final version into video format (any video file okay)
- Upload video presentation (link will be provided to presenters via email)



 - You do not need to go out and buy a new outfit






Recognition

- Recognize peer-reviewed publications of outstanding undergraduate research, scholarship or creative activity
 - Open to all academic disciplines
 - Publication must have DOI (digital object identifier)
- Must be a currently enrolled student (any year!)
- Quick application, just link to your publication and provide info about your contributions to the research.
- \$500 award
- Application deadline:
 May 7th 2020 at 11:59 PM





Research Rockstars Video Contest

- Undergrad Slam Video Contest for undergraduates to showcase their research, scholarship or design project
- Modeled after the UC Grad Slam
- Make a 3-minute video explaining your research and its impact
- 1st place: \$500, 2nd place: \$300, 3rd place: \$200 (several categories!)
